## ACTIVATION OF LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS FOR UNIVERSITIES

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Learning management system is linked fully with the student information system so:

- 1. The courses are set up automatically on the learning management system, if any, the student information system.
- 2. The inclusion; students and teachers automatically recording the decisions in their respective roles.
- 3. Programmer performs an automatic update of information, decisions, and users twice a day.

And is now working to achieve automatic transition grades students from the learning management system to the student information system.

A summary of the studies and research carried out to develop a system to deal with:

- 1. Study Weekly and monthly continuing to measure user activity on the system.
- 2. The quarterly study on the details of using the system, decisions, sources, interaction
  - 3. The quarterly study to measure and analyze the reactions of the faculty.

  - 5. Academy graduate studies with the support of the university, such as:

- b) Faculty Conceptions and Practices in ICT-enhanced Teaching Environments in Higher Education.
- 6. Academic studies with the support of the university designed and carried out and published by faculty members.
- 7. Assessment studies by independent third parties, such as the recent study by the ROI Institute to measure the impact of e-learning for education at the university and modes of development, attended by hundreds of students and teachers.
