Our long-term partnership will be build taking into account an specific focus of the IF PAN research priorities which include depression, schizophrenia, chronic pain, drug and natural rewards and addiction, anxiety, post-traumatic stress disorder, neurodegenerative and immunoendocrine processes and phytochemistry and experience of NTU "KhPI" in fundamental investigations, practical solution of specific technical and technological medical-pharmaceutical issues.
